**Samburu** - North of Nairobi in the hot, arid fringes of the vast northern region of Kenya, the lands of the Samburu people, close relatives of the Masai.

# Safaris in Kenya

## Masai Safari 7 Nights/8 Days ex Nairobi

### Day 1, Monday or Saturday: Nairobi

Met on arrival at the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in Nairobi and transferred to the Nairobi Serena Hotel. The remainder of the day is at leisure or choose from a selection of optional excursions (book and pay locally). Overnight at the Nairobi Serena Hotel on bed and breakfast basis.

### Day 2, Tuesday or Sunday: Samburu

After breakfast drive north through rich farming areas and across the Equator to the semi-arid and rugged landscape of Samburu National Reserve (360 kms). After lunch proceed on a late afternoon game-drive. Dinner and overnight at the Samburu Serena Lodge.

### Day 3, Wednesday or Monday: Samburu

Early morning and late afternoon game-drives enable you to see wildlife unique to this arid yet beautiful part of Kenya. Breakfast, lunch, dinner and overnight at

the Samburu Serena Lodge.

### Day 4, Thursday or Tuesday: Mount Kenya

After breakfast drive to the slopes of Mount Kenya and check-in at Mountain Lodge (240 kms). Spend the afternoon viewing game from the lodge or join a nature walk (weather permitting) led by a local guide. Dinner and overnight at Mountain Lodge.

### Day 5, Friday or Wednesday: Lake Nakuru

After breakfast drive into the Great Rift Valley to the Lake Nakuru National Park arriving in time for lunch (240 kms). Enjoy a late afternoon game-drive in the park host to flamingoes and the endangered rhinos among other big game species along the lakes shore. Dinner and overnight at the Lake Nakuru Lodge.

### Day 6, Saturday or Thursday: Masai Mara

After an early breakfast drive to the world

famous Masai Mara Game Reserve arriving at the Mara Serena Lodge with lunch and a game-drive en route (370 kms). Dinner and overnight at the Mara Serena Lodge.

### Day 7, Sunday or Friday: Masai Mara

An early morning balloon safari over the Mara followed by a bubbly bush breakfast (optional extra) or take an early morning game-drive followed by breakfast at the lodge. Rest of the morning at leisure at the lodge. After lunch proceed on a late afternoon game-drive. Dinner and overnight at the Mara Serena Lodge.

### Day 8, Monday or Saturday: Depart

After breakfast return to Nairobi (360 kms) and proceed with your chosen extension or return home.

## Thorn Tree Safari 5 Days/4 Nights ex Nairobi

### Day 1, Tuesday or Saturday: Aberdares

Met on arrival at the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in Nairobi and transferred to the Safari Lounge to freshen-up. Later drive north through the rich farming areas arriving at the Outspan Hotel in time for lunch (180 kms). After lunch transfer to Treetops in the lodges own vehicle with overnight bags (main luggage is stored at the Outspan Hotel for collection the following day). Afternoon at leisure to enjoy excellent views of animals visiting the waterhole from the observation platforms of the lodge. Dinner and overnight at Treetops.

### Day 2, Wednesday or Sunday: Lake Nakuru/Lake Naivasha

Early in the morning transfer to Outspan

Hotel for breakfast. After collecting left luggage drive into the Great Rift Valley to Lake Nakuru National Park arriving in time for lunch (180 kms). Afternoon game-drive. Drive to Lake Naivasha Simba Lodge for dinner and overnight stay.

### Day 3, Thursday or Monday: Masai Mara

After an early breakfast drive to the world famous Masai Mara Game Reserve arriving in time for lunch at the lodge (260 kms). Enjoy a late afternoon game-drive in one of the world's finest game reserves. Dinner and overnight at the Mara Simba Lodge.

### Day 4, Friday or Tuesday: Masai Mara

An early morning balloon safari over the

Mara followed by a bubbly bush breakfast (optional extra) or take an early morning game-drive followed by breakfast at the lodge. Rest of the morning at leisure at the lodge. After lunch proceed on a late afternoon game-drive. Dinner and overnight at the Mara Simba Lodge.

### Day 5, Saturday Or Wednesday: Depart

After breakfast return to Nairobi (300 kms) and proceed with your chosen extension or return home.

## Mara By Air (Mara Intrepids) 4 Days/3 Nights ex Nairobi

### Day 1, Daily: Masai Mara

Transfer to the Wilson airport in Nairobi for a scheduled flight by light aircraft (maximum baggage allowance 15 kgs) to Masai Mara Game Reserve (approximately 45 minutes). Met on arrival at the airstrip and transferred to the Mara Intrepids. After lunch at the lodge enjoy a late afternoon game-drive in the reserve which is the northern extension of the Serengeti ecosystem. Dinner and overnight at the Mara Intrepids.

### Day 2, Daily: Masai Mara

Early morning balloon safari over the Mara followed by a bubbly bush breakfast (optional extra) or a game-drive followed by breakfast at the lodge. Rest of the morning at leisure. After lunch enjoy a late afternoon game-drive. Dinner and overnight at the Mara Intrepids.

### Day 3, Daily: Masai Mara

Early morning balloon safari over the Mara followed by a bubbly bush breakfast

(optional extra) or a game-drive followed by breakfast at the lodge. Rest of the morning at leisure. After lunch enjoy a late afternoon game-drive. Dinner and overnight at the Mara Intrepids.

### Day 4, Daily: Depart

After breakfast transfer to the airstrip for a scheduled flight by light aircraft (maximum baggage allowance 15 kgs) to Nairobi. Met on arrival and proceed with chosen option.

### Day 2: Daily: Samburu

Early morning and late afternoon game-drives enable you to see wildlife unique to this arid yet beautiful part of Kenya. Breakfast, lunch, dinner and overnight at the Ashnil Samburu Camp.

### Day 3: Daily: Masai Mara

After breakfast, flight from Samburu to Masai Mara (approximately 1 hr 30 minutes). Met on arrival at airstrip and transferred to the Main Governors Camp. After lunch, enjoy a late afternoon game-drive. Dinner and overnight at Main Governors Camp.

### Day 4: Daily: Masai Mara

Early morning balloon safari over the Mara followed by a bubbly bush breakfast (optional extra) or a game-drive followed by breakfast at the Camp. Rest of the morning at leisure. After lunch enjoy a late afternoon game-drive. Dinner and overnight at the Main Governors Camp.

### Day 5: Daily: Depart

After breakfast transfer to the airstrip for a scheduled flight by light aircraft (maximum baggage allowance 15 kgs) to Nairobi. Met on arrival and proceed with chosen option.

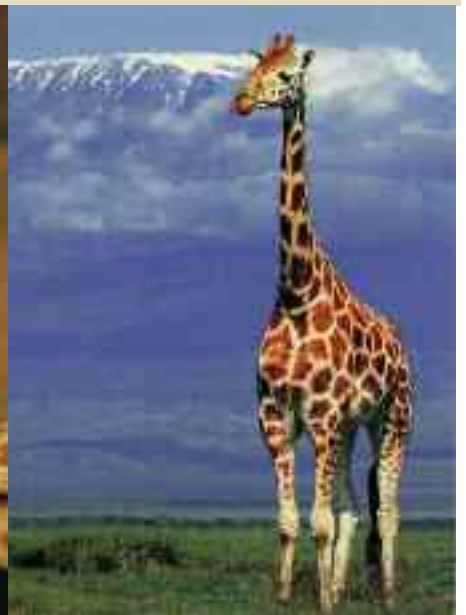
